Local and travel info for the VIII-th International conference "SOLITONS, COLLAPSES AND TURBULENCE: Achievements, Developments and Perspectives"

Local weather: Typical temperature is ~ 18° C but unstable, could be quite warm (up ~ 25° C) but can also quickly drop down to ~ 10° C with rains also possible.

Conference Location: The main building of the Landau Institute for Theoretical Physics at Chernogolovka, Moscow Region, Russia.

Transportation: We recommend to arrive by May 20 to Chernogolovka. Also it will be a special Landau Institute bus arranged on May 21 to depart at 7:30am from Moscow to the conference. The bus will wait at the crossing of Shchelkovskoe shosse and ulitsa 11th Parkovaya just on the other side from the main coach terminal (metro station "Shchelkovskoe"), approximately 300 meters from this corner to the direction of Moscow region (see Google map). On the bus window you will find the sign "Solitons, Collapses and Turbulence".

Another way to travel to Chernogolovka from Moscow any day is to take a regular shuttle no. 320 or buses 320 or 360 at the bus terminal (metro station "Shchelkovskoe"). The bus fare is 100 rubles. You can also use Uber (would need access from app to arrange Uber), taxi or any similar service to go from Moscow to Chernogolovka. Prices vary from about 1200 rubles and up. Taxi service is usually a little more expensive and the cost is recommended to be negotiated in advance.

For people who decide to reach Chernogolovka from the airport Sheremet'evo (SVO) without our assistance, the cheapest way to take the aeroexpress (train) from SVO to Metro (subway) station "Belorousskaya" (35 min) or from the airport Domodedovo to Metro station "Paveletskaya" (40 min) (he price 420 rubles), then proceed by metro to Metro station "Shchelkovskaya". A Metro map can be found in each car of the Metro. Aeroexpresses from these airports depart to Moscow each half hour, except night time. One can also use Uber, taxi or similar services directly from the airport to Chernogolovka. Prices starts from 2000 rubles for Uber and generally higher for taxi (the taxi cost is recommended to be negotiated in advance).

Meals: Organizing Committee will provide free lunches for all participants who pays the registration fee. Breakfasts and dinners options are available from local businesses.

The conference opening: 9:15am on Sunday, May the 21st. All other

conference days will start at 9:00am. The format of oral presentations is 30 minutes including questions. Lunch break will be from 12-50 till 14-10. The welcome party and the conference dinner will be in the Landau Institute on Sunday evening, 21st and on Wednesday evening, May 24th, respectively. The tentative program (not a final variant) is attached.
